Distance Learning Student Information

As we begin our journey with distance learning we will do our best to work with parents and students during this first nine weeks to facilitate an excellent learning environment.

We know that this will be a challenging first nine weeks with distance learning for students, teachers, and most of all, the person that is assisting the student at home with the learning.

It will be the responsibility of the parent to make sure that the students log into the Zoom meetings as scheduled for the live instruction (this will be how we take attendance for the day) and that the students complete and turn in all work on time. This will ensure that the student is not behind when they do come back to class.

Each classroom teacher, K-5, will schedule a live Zoom instruction lesson for Math, ELA and Religion every day for 30-40 minutes. Science and Social Studies will rotate with live instruction once a week. All lessons and assignments will be listed on the teacher's Google Classroom page for that grade level. All live instruction will be recorded and posted to Google Classroom in the event someone misses a class. A weekly calendar will be posted Monday morning with the assignments and activities for that week.

3K and 4K will have a different schedule that will be given to those parents, next week.

During the transition week, there will be no required assignments for either face to face or distance learning students. **Teachers will practice the Zoom meetings for 3K, 4K and Kinder on Thursday, August 20th; grades 1-5 on Wednesday, August 19th.**

Actual instruction for grading purposes will begin on Monday, August 24th for all students.

All students should have checked out the technology and textbooks they need for the classes. Any worksheets, PDFs on the Google Classroom pages will be the responsibility of the parent to print out.

As our teachers are working with both face to face and distance learning this year, we ask that you respect their family time away from school. Please limit the phone calls, text and emails to Monday – Friday before 6:00pm. You may schedule a call during their conference periods if needed.
